*"The Roots of the Civil War; "How our Forefathers Passed the Buck"*

**Sarah Bayrd:** Ms. Bayrd holds a B.A. in History from the University of Kentucky a Masters from Trevecca Nazarene University in Administration and Supervision. She taught Advanced Placement U.S. History for over 34 years and introduced A.P. U.S. History to Williamson County. She has also won many accolades including Williamson County Teacher of the Year, before retiring in 2006.

*"Storm Clouds on the Horizon: Nashville in the Decade before the War"*

**Carole S. Bucy:** Ms. Bucy is currently a professor of history at Volunteer State Community College. She received a B.A. in American History from Baylor University, her M.A. in American History from George Peabody College and a Ph.D. in American History from Vanderbilt University. She is the Vice President of the Tennessee Historical Society and is the author of many books and articles, including two elementary school textbooks. Her interests are the Civil War years, women in politics and Tennessee History.

*"Spies, Scouts, and Guerillas: Irregular Warfare in Middle Tennessee"*

**Myers Brown:** Mr. Brown holds a B.A. in history from Oglethorpe University and a M.A. in Public History from Middle Tennessee State University. He has served as Curator of Military History at the Atlanta History Center and was Curator of the Joe Wheeler Home, "Pond Spring" in Alabama. He then joined the Tennessee State Museum in 2005 and currently serves as Curator of Extension Services. He has published many articles and book reviews. He also serves as a Governor and Secretary of the Company of Military Historians and was elected a Fellow in May 2008.

*"Finding Peace: Reconstruction Middle Tennessee"*

**Krista Castillo:** Ms. Castillo holds a B.A. in History from Mt. Union College and in May 2010, she will graduate from Austin Peay State University with a M.A. in Military History. She formerly served as Registrar at Customs House Museum & Cultural Center. Ms. Castillo currently serves as President of the Nashville Civil War Roundtable and is on the Board of the Inter-Museum Council of Nashville. She is the Interim Museum Coordinator of the Fort Negley Visitors Center.

*"Appomattox: The Place of Lee's Surrender and a National Resurrection"*

**Thomas Flagel:** Mr. Flagel holds degrees from Loras College, Kansas State University, Creighton University, and has studied at Vienna University. Currently, he teaches American History at Columbia State Community College. Already an accomplished author of books on the Civil War, WWII, and the American Presidency, he is currently working on a volume concerning Abraham Lincoln.

**John Allyn:** Mr. Allyn is a New York native who graduated with a B.A. in History and a J.D. from Vanderbilt University. He has practiced law in Nashville since 1973. A 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant in the U.S. Army and retired Lt. Colonel in the U.S. Army Reserves, he is a Persian Gulf War veteran. Currently Vice President and President Elect of the Nashville City Cemetery Association, Mr. Allyn leads the annual Civil War Tour. He is also a board member of The Battle of Nashville Preservation Society, Inc.
